Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of our mind. The church is needed to feed those who are born from water and Spirit at the proper time. Our responses based on the Bible: Ulterior Motives of the Breakaways

1. They are trying to hide their motives with a number of verses. Their hidden agenda is to unite but not to centralize. By that, it means everyone is free to do whatever church work they desire. They can go anywhere they want to do sacraments. They know their movement will be very much restricted if the church as a whole were to determine their suitability for doing church work.

2. Since they are not accepted by the church to serve because of their ill mentality and unrefined behaviour, they would not be allowed to serve without genuine repentance. In justifying their deeds, in subtlety, they go round promoting rebellion against the church, thinking that they are able to bring more onto their bandwagon of falsity, to attack the True Jesus Church.

Biblical Principles

1. In the early church, the church in Jerusalem functioned as the headquarters in sending workers to help out with newly pioneered areas such as Peter and John were sent to help with the believers in Samaria to pray for the Holy Spirit (Acts 8:14-16).

2. The church in Jerusalem also helped with resolving matters pertaining to the truth (Acts 15). When the church was persecuted, some travelled as far as Antioch preaching the word of God to the Jews only. When the Lord worked with the believers there, the church in Jerusalem sent to them Barnabas (Acts 11:22). In a way, the church functioned in a centralized manner.

3. From a regional or local church perspective, the church has appointed workers to look after the church. However, the workers sent out from the region of churches or the local church must be of one purpose and mind with other TJCs. Just like the church in Antioch, when the workers were sent out, they did not go out attacking the mother church in Jerusalem or the beliefs of the apostolic church.

4. The true spirit of unity comes from being willing to submit to one another. Each should be clothed with humility (1 Pet 5:5). Practically, this means we submit under the mighty hand of God (1 Pet 5:6). This is how the church should function locally, regionally, nationally or even internationally.

1. It is clear from the movement of the breakaway group. They are deceived by pride, thinking that they can play around with the principles of God without paying a hefty price. They are really fooling themselves.
