Once the local church has completed its preliminary review, the application should be forwarded to Preacher Fook Fah Chong, Head of the UKGA Department of Religious Affairs, by email at ff.chong@tjc.org.uk. Subject to the approval of the UKGA Board, interviews will be arranged with suitable candidates.
4. We kindly ask the board members of all local churches, prayer houses and places of worship to regularly remind their congregations through church announcements. Please also encourage the youth during sermons to dedicate their lives to serving the Lord.

5. Lastly, we hope that all our brethren will continually remember this divine work in your prayers—asking the Lord Jesus Christ to move more brothers and sisters to willingly answer His calling and serve faithfully in His house.
